Wanggoobla Creek - Fraser Island, Australia

Winding through the rainforest on this small but beautiful island, Wanggobla Creek boasts white

sands and clear, icy waters. It's less famous than Eli Creek, so if you're looking for somewhere a little

more off the beaten track then this will be right up your street.

Where to stay: Dingos Resort

Pines State Beach and is home to one of San Diego's most famous surf spots.

Where to stay: Beach Bungalow Hostel

Tegenungan Waterfall – Bali

Drive about 15 minutes' south of Ubud and you'll find a green valley with the huge, gushing

Tegenungan Waterfall running through it. Unless you arrive early you won't have this place all to

yourself, but on a hot Bali day there's no better place to cool off, surrounded by mountains and

tropical palm trees above.

Where to Stay: In Da Lodge

Situated close to Ubud's main attractions and the perfect destination to meet fellow travellers.

Samurai Beach - Port Stephens, Australia

Close to family friend One-Mile Beach, Samurai is entirely clothing-optional. Making friends while

playing naked beach volleyball is a distinct possibility.

Where to Stay: Melaleuca Surfside Backpackers

A social hostel ideal for surfers and boarders.

Bellevue Beach - Copenhagen, Denmark

A Copenhagen summer's day is well-spent exploring the many nooks and secrets of Copenhagen's

harbour. When you've had enough of admiring the other boats and houseboats, it's time to shed your

clothes and get your paddle on across the 700 metre beach just 15 minutes from central Copenhagen.

Where to Stay: Urban House

the sand and sea.
