DIVA MARIAH CAREY STAYS IN *HOSTEL* ON TRIP TO BARCELONA

LONDON, 10th April 2018: Legendary diva, Mariah Carey, took a break from her lavish lifestyle to join backpackers on a recent trip to Barcelona – and actually stayed in a hostel. Known for outlandish diva demands, from ordering dog chauffeurs to demanding 20 white kittens and 100 doves for a performance and even having bodyguards watch her eat, Mariah surprised everyone when she exclaimed the hostel was "fabulous"!

Swapping her luxury £25,000-a-month (£830 per night) mansion for a room in the <u>Casa Gracia</u>, where prices start from just £30 a night, Mariah took advantage of all the facilities on offer, including the fully equipped kitchen with free 24-hour coffee, cocktail bar with resident DJ, and of course a private room.

She was in the Spanish city filming a short film for global hostel-booking platform <u>Hostelworld</u> about the huge changes that have occurred in the budget travel industry over the past decade and how today hostels have fantastic, modern features to meet even the biggest diva's demands.

She rounded the day off by enjoying a drink in the cocktail bar with backpackers from around the world, before dancing on a table to her own double platinum hit 'Fantasy', complete with gold sequins and white doves.

Commenting on the film, Mariah Carey said: "For some reason, someone thought it would be funny to book me in a hostel. To mine and everyone's surprise, the hostel was fabulous! It was super clean, modern and spacious. I say give hostels a go, it could be a great choice for all you world travellers out there!"
