Cost: From £45 per night during NYFW

London

At any time of year, London's most fashionable hotels will cost a fortune. Save your pounds by

checking out its most fashionable hostels instead when London Fashion Week rolls around from

September 16th to 20th.

Where to stay: Astor Hyde Park, South Kensington

Located in the most beautiful and charming neighbourhood in London, Astor Hyde Park is one

minute from Hyde Park and surrounded by some of London's greatest museums including the

fashion and art famous Victoria & Albert Museum. Cost: From £21 per night during London Fashion

Where to stay: Clink 78

Where to stay: Ostello Bello Grande, Via Roberto Lepetit

Only 50 meters from Milan Central Station, this Hoscar-level hostel boasts quirky décor that blends

style with kitsch substance - especially in the beautiful private rooms available. The cool team at

Ostello Bello Grande create a special social atmosphere in a setting that would remind you of the

trendiest parts of Shoreditch, especially it's Hoxton outdoor terrace. Cost: From £31 per night during

The last of the Big Four cities' fashion weeks, Paris fashion week runs from September 27th until

October 5th. Hanging around fashion types for this length of time will leave you needing someone to

talk to, and the city's trendiest hostels will be the perfect place to chill.

Where to stay: Les Piaules, Boulevard de Belleville
